- **Comprehension:** Unseen Passages (अपठित बोध) and question evaluation.
- **Hindi Literature:** Famous Poets, Authors, and their iconic creations/books (प्रसिद्ध कवि, लेखक एवं उनकी रचनाएँ).

- **Schedules & Public Services:** Constitutional Schedules, structure of All India Services and their standard recruitment methodology.
